Terms and conditions of payment

Online Registration

The online registration is determined by the payment of registration fees by credit card. CAUTION : if you use a "E-credit-card", payment by instalments is not possible.

Cash payment : fees payment in full and at once when you enter your data.

3 instalments payment : authorised if total fees due exceed 300 euros, and if you enter your data **on September 20 at the latest**. The first instalment is immediate. The second and third direct debits will occur 30 days apart, from date to date.

In person Registration

Cash payment: payment possible either by credit card, or by transfer payment, or in cash if total is ≤ 300 euros, or by cheque to the account of "Agent comptable de l'Institut polytechnique de Grenoble" (a single cheque, including all registration costs).

3 instalments payment : possible only by credit card to the debt collection Agency. Authorised if registration occurs **on September 21 at the latest, and if** total fees due exceed 300 euros. The first instalment is immediate, the second and third direct debits will occur 30 days apart, from date to date.

The replacement cost of a student card is € 15.50

⇒ **REFORM OF THE STUDENT SOCIAL SECURITY**

From the start of the academic year 2018/2019, the registration at the Social Security is free.
Please refer to the following chart to read carefully the conditions to register at the Social Security, according to your case :

REREGISTRATION IN HIGHER EDUCATION Registration at the Social Security : <u>automatic, without any steps nor any costs</u>	
Student for the academic year 2017/2018 and registered at the Social Security through a student Social Security centre via (LMDE or SMER) : → upholding of the registration at the student Social Security on equal terms (no change of paying centre is possible), <u>Only for the academic year 2018/2019</u>	
Student for the academic year 2017/2018 and not registered at the Social Security because because under 20 years old on August 31, 2018 : → upholding in the same Social Security scheme (often the parents'one)	
1 st REGISTRATION IN HIGHER EDUCATION	
Registration at the Social Security : <u>automatic, without any steps nor any costs</u>	Metropolitan French national → upholding in the same Social Security scheme (often the parents'one)
Registration to Social Security : <u>compulsory steps, free, connecting to</u> www.etudiant-etranger.ameli.fr	Non Metropolitan French national, coming from overseas departments, enjoying an independent Social Security scheme peculiar to non Metropolitan French nationals. Foreign nationals outside European Union (EU), European Economic Area (EEA), Switzerland
SPECIFIC CASES <i>(needing to contact the Health Insurance Office – Caisse Primaire d'assurance Maladie / CPAM – except for the European Health Insurance Card holders)</i>	
Foreign nationals from European Union (EU), European Economic Area (EEA), Switzerland : → upholding of the health coverage thanks to : - the European Health Insurance Card (EHIC) or - the S1 Form which enables the registration at the French Social Security for a management by a French Health Insurance Office while keeping a final care of health expenses by the State of origin	
Foreign nationals outside European Union (EU), European Economic Area (EEA), Switzerland but whose State of origin (Andorra, Canada, Monaco...) is signatory to a <u>specific bilateral treaty with France</u> → upholding of the conditions of entitlement to the Social Security provided that the student shall benefit from a valid residence permit if needed	

⇒ **COMPLEMENTARY HEALTH INSURANCE**

The subscription to a Complementary Health Insurance is highly recommended to guarantee the complementary refund of your health expenses which wouldn't be covered by the Social Security.
If you don't benefit yet from a complementary health insurance and if you want to take one out, you can directly chose an organisation by yourself.

⇒ **LIABILITY INSURANCE**

Any registration at a higher education institution is subject to the compulsory presentation of a supporting document regarding the liability insurance.
If you benefit yet from such a liability insurance, the terms "Liability Insurance Coverage for Student Life and Personal Privacy / Garantie Responsabilité Civile Etudiante & Vie Privée" have to be explicitly specified on the supporting document. If the the contract doesn't cover the entire academic year, you undertake to renew it in order to assure its coverage until the end of the academic year.
Otherwise, you must chose an organisation by yourself to be insured and get a supporting document which will have to explicitly specify the words mentioned above.
