# ADMINISTRATIVE REGISTRATION

At your arrival in the school, you have to start your administrative registration if this is not yet done.

It is done in 2 phases :

## 1) The pre-registration

You have to pay your CVEC (Student Life and Campus Contribution) which amounts to 100€ for the 2023/2024 academic year. After that, proceed to your online registration and pay the tuition fee for your course on the grenoble-inp website.

## 2) La chaîne d'inscription

The second phase is the registration chain which takes place at the school's premises from 22 August to 22 September 2023 :

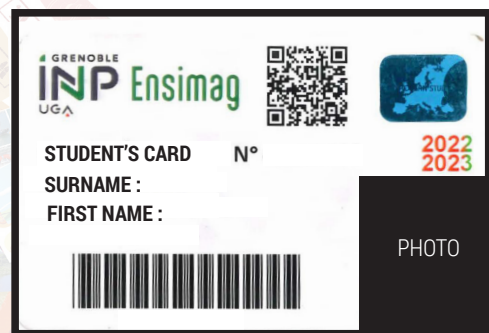
- Sign your registration form
- Get your student card
- Get your registration certificate.

You have to finalise your registration at most a week after your resumption date. If you encounter any difficulty doing so, contact the student affairs department immediately.

## THE STUDENT CARD

The student card justifies your registration as a student and grants you access to :

- Complete meals (starter, main meal and dessert) at a reduced price (3€30) in all university restaurants and cafeterias owned by CROUS.
- Different equipments in school and on campus : University Libraries, classrooms, department for sports activities.
- Free printing on the photocopiers and scanners in the school and on campus (limited by your subscription)
- Preferential rates in certain cinemas, shows, museums, shops, public transportation, sports, etc.





# INTERNSHIPS

Internships form an integral part of your studies in Ensimag. They allow you to practice what you have learnt, to discover different professional environments and prepare your career.

## Engineering Students

### Assistant Engineer Internship

The internship in 2nd year is the assistant engineering internship for a minimum of 8 weeks. It allows you to apply your academic knowledge in the professional environment and to understand how it works.

### End of studies project

The internship in 3rd year called «end of studies project» is compulsory in order to validate your degree. This internship lasts for a minimum of 20 weeks. It is based on a mission of 5 to 6 months, under a technical or industrial project in engineering which will be defended at the end of your 3rd year.

**Optional internships :** You can do some optional internships during your studies either at the end of your 1st or 2nd year for a minimum of 4 weeks (workman internships or assistant engineer internships.)

## Master Students

### Short internships

The short internship is compulsory in the 1st year of your masters for a duration of 1-2 months. This grants you the opportunity to discover the professional world either in a company or in a laboratory.

### Long internships

This is the same as the end of studies project of the engineering course. This takes place in the 2nd semester of the second year of your masters and allows you to have a significant first professional experience.





# INTERNSHIPS

Other than compulsory courses in Ensimag, you also have some services at your disposal to help in your search for internship.

## The «Espace Information Emploi» of Grenoble INP-UGA

The career building helps students all year round by organising workshops for the writing and correction of CV's, motivation letters, usage of social media platforms and trainings for interviews. You can meet them at the following address : 46 avenue Félix Viallet in Grenoble.

## FEEL Forum (Companies and Students Forum)

This is a major event of the resumption period. The FEEL forum grants you an opportunity to discover internship and work opportunities offered by numerous local, national and international companies in the school's sectors of specialisation.

## The Grenoble INP-UGA Career Center

## STEEL Forum

This event is mostly for students in the 2nd year of the engineering program. This helps them to easily find an assistant engineering internship which is difficult to get due to its short duration.

# STUDENTS WITH SPECIAL NEEDS

To accompany students to succeed in their different pathways, Université Grenoble Alpes and Grenoble-INP -UGA made arrangements for students with special needs.



## HIGH LEVEL ATHLETES :

If you practice a sport and have a good national level or if you are classed under the ministerial list in your speciality, you can qualify for some modifications in your studies : studying for 4 years instead of 3, course waivers, adjustments to favour your travelling for competitions.



**HIGH LEVEL ARTISTS :** Status of high level student artist allows you to benefit from examination modifications, or exemptions from some courses in order to make your practice and studies more comfortable for you : exemption from some classes in case you need to travel in the course of your artistic practice, etc.

## COMMITTED STUDENTS :

If you participate in some associative or communal activities, you can benefit from some modifications in the course of your studies. The engaged student's document can be found in a charter available on the Grenoble-INP-UGA website.

## STUDENT ENTREPRENEURS:

If you are a student with the plan of starting up a business or company, or if you already have your business, the school has a way of helping you combine entrepreneurship with your studies : coaching sessions on business and company creations, exemption from some courses, etc.

## STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES :

If you are disabled or suffering from a chronic illness, you can benefit from some modifications that will allow you study without stress.

After meeting with a doctor in the disabled reception service of UGA, propositions of modifications will be made by him to the director of studies for validation : studying for 4 years, terms and conditions and guidance for courses, eased conditions of examination, etc.

# DIGITAL ACADEMIC PLATFORMS

During your studies in Ensimag, you will be asked to use some academic platforms to consult your timetable, or your results, access some communicational materials, submit your assignments, etc. Here are the major ones :

## ● ADE :

ADE is a platform that grants you access to your timetable. Your timetable is personalised and you will only see the courses which you have chosen. If you notice any error in your timetable, contact the student affairs department.

## ● Chamilo :

Chamilo is a platform that grants you access to lecture materials made available to you online by your lecturers.

## ● REFENS :

REFENS is a platform that grants you access to description and terms of assessments for your courses.

## ● ZENITH :

ZENITH is a platform that grants you access to the list of your courses and mailing list of the lecturers involved.

## ● TEIDE :

TEIDE is a platform where you can submit files to be examined by lecturers.

## CONCERNING COMPUTER EQUIPMENTS

To ease your personal work, the ownership of a personal computer is recommended but not compulsory. The computers in the rooms for practical works can be used freely when the rooms are not occupied for lectures.

(The computer will be made available to students depending on the numbers available and the approval of the director of academics)

## GETTING CONNECTED

# RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE SCHOOL

As a student at Ensimag, you agree to respect the functioning of the school and its internal regulations. During your registration, you signed some documents stating your rights and obligations for the wellbeing of everyone :

- Equality and diversity charter,
- Anti-plagiarism charter,
- Form of image rights,
- Usage of all systems and the RENATER network charter,
- Audiovisual and digital documents usage charter.

Your studies in Ensimag are also regulated by the studies regulation (regulation of studies for engineering or work and study engineering programs or master and their annexes). You will find all the rules related to the acquisition of your final certificate, tests, validation of course units, internships, on the school's intranet..

It is advised that you take note of the reglementations of the department in which you are registered.

Here are some key points of the documents that you should have in mind :

## **Attendance :**

Presence in all courses and educational activities is compulsory. In case you are absent, you must inform the lecturer in charge as soon as possible and the student affairs department with a document that justifies it.

Lecturers can score you a 0 in examinations or assessments if you have unjustified absence during your school year.

## **Assessments :**

All courses are assessed per semester.

For engineering courses, all the UE (course units) must be validated seperately to grant you access to the next session.

The course units do not compensate. A zero or an unjustified absence in an examination automatically results to the failure of the course unit even though your average score in other subjects of that course unit is higher than 10.

You still have to participate in sports classes even though you have been exempted from a physical activity. The instructor will give you an activity that is compatible with your health, and that will be scored.

You cannot retake all courses. You can find more information about this on REFENS.



# RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE SCHOOL

## Personal digital tools :

The use of mobile phones during lectures is forbidden no matter the reason. Laptops can only be used if accepted by the lecturer.

## Collective equipments and materials :

The school has made available hardwares and some other equipments. They are for general use and should be well taken care of by everyone. We ask that you take utmost care of these materials, furnitures and school equipments.

All breakdown or technical problems must be declared :

- To the IT department for equipments in the work rooms,
- To [help.batiments@ensimag.fr](mailto:help.batiments@ensimag.fr) for other matters.
- Found or recovered objects should be given to the welcome desk.

## Plagiarism :

All forms of plagiarism is forbidden : «Plagiarism consists of reducing a text or part of a text, illustration, or ideas of an author without citing him properly by a bibliographical or iconographical reference.» (article 1 of the UGA anti-plagiarism charter).

«Suspected perpetrators of plagiarism will be taken to the disciplinary committee who will impose sanctions which could be as worse as expulsion from all higher education institutions in France. This disciplinary procedure does not exempt you from possible court proceedings» (article 5 of the UGA anti-plagiarism charter).

## Interacting with lecturers and the school's administration :

The personnels of the school will contact you only by your school e-mail with the [grenoble-inp.org](mailto:gre@grenoble-inp.org) domaine. You have to consult it regularly, respond as soon as possible to requests sent to you and use the same e-mail to contact the school.

Note : mails coming from certain domaines are filtered and do not reach the required destinations (ex gmail).

Make sure you configure the end of your mails to have your surname, firstname, year of study, specialisation and group as the case may be.

# SEXUAL AND SEXIST VIOLENCE, DISCRIMINATION AND HARASSMENT

Grenoble INP-UGA holds a policy that favors equality between men and women and fights against discriminations. Ensimag vividly engages to fight against all forms of discrimination linked to : disabilities, health, social and ethnic origins, age, gender, sexual orientations, etc.

You have at your disposal, different services put in place to encourage diversity and reduce discrimination in the school. For example :

- Providing free distribution of pads and menstrual protections on campus.
- Organising workshops to raise awareness against sexual and sexist violence, discrimination and harassment.
- Providing services to welcome and accompany migrants, refugees and asylum seekers.
- Installing the «disability reception» department to develop and accompany students with a disability... and all others.

**No tolerance will be given to any discriminatory or disrespectful behaviour.**

## DECLARING A DISCRIMINATORY OR SEXUAL HARASSING SITUATION

If you fall victim or you are a witness of any discriminative or harassing situation, the school has provided you with a form to declare the situation. You just have to describe what you faced or witnessed without mentioning the name of the perpetrator. The team in charge will contact you and have a word with you in all confidentiality. The form can be found online.



## BEING ACCOMPANIED AS A VICTIM

UGA and its establishments Grenoble INP-UGA and ENSAG-UGA have signed an agreement with the judiciary court of Grenoble concerning the declaration of sexual and sexist violence in collaboration with France Victime 38 (FV38) in Grenoble - an association that offers social intervention and help to victims. 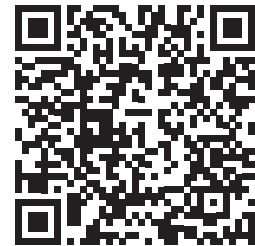
# THE RESPECT AND EQUALITY TEAM

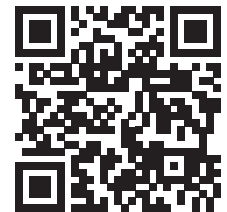

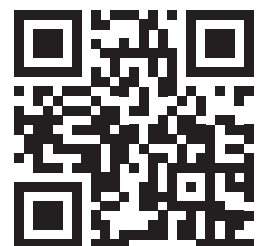

## OPENING OF THE SCHOOL'S PREMISES

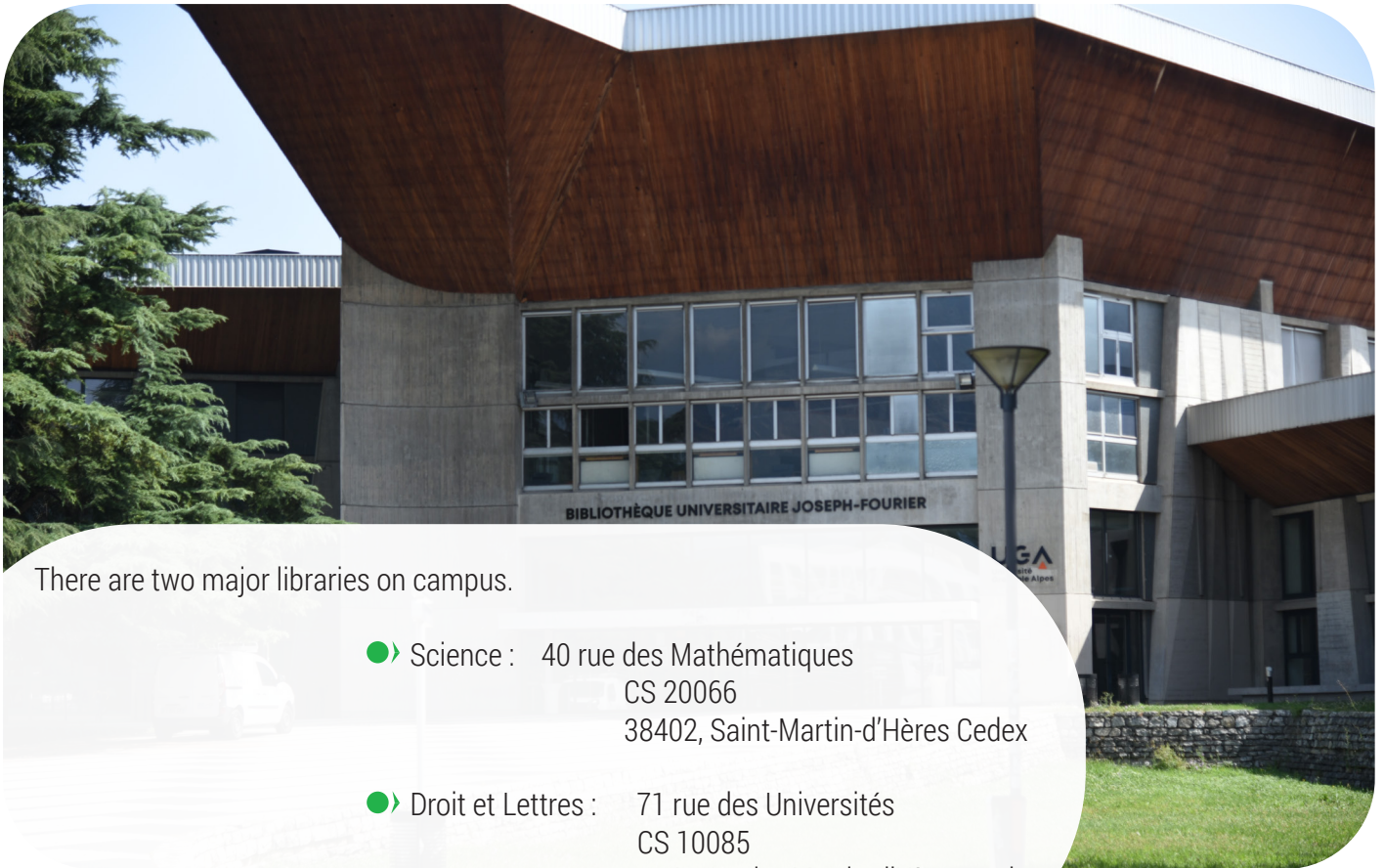

# GETTING ACCOMMODATION AND SETTLING IN AT LOW COST

There are many housing in and around grenoble. You can rent a selfcon, an apartment, a room in a private home or in a shared home (shared housing). They can be rented on a long or short term basis.

## FINDING AN ACCOMMODATION

**CROUS housing** : You can go on the CROUS [website](#) to apply for student housing all year round.



**LOKAVIZ** : In partnership with CROUS, this site proposes housing offers only for students. Once you pay your CVEC contribution, you will be able to contact owners of private homes and rent your accommodation.

**Lodging sites** : Se loger, Le bon coin, La carte des colocs, Studapart proposes housing offers that are available for rent. These offers are of different types and are sometimes for a long duration ( one school year of more).

## BENEFIT FROM HOUSING AIDS

Health insurance is compulsory in France. For international students, you have to create an account on the [etudiant-etranger.ameli.fr](http://etudiant-etranger.ameli.fr) website to benefit from the health care insurance of the french state. You can also read the [UGA brochure](#) (in English) to get more detailed information on steps to follow as an international student in France.

The health insurance from the french state is free but partial. You need to have a complementary health insurance to be fully covered. The french state can also cover your health insurance fully and for free under certain conditions. 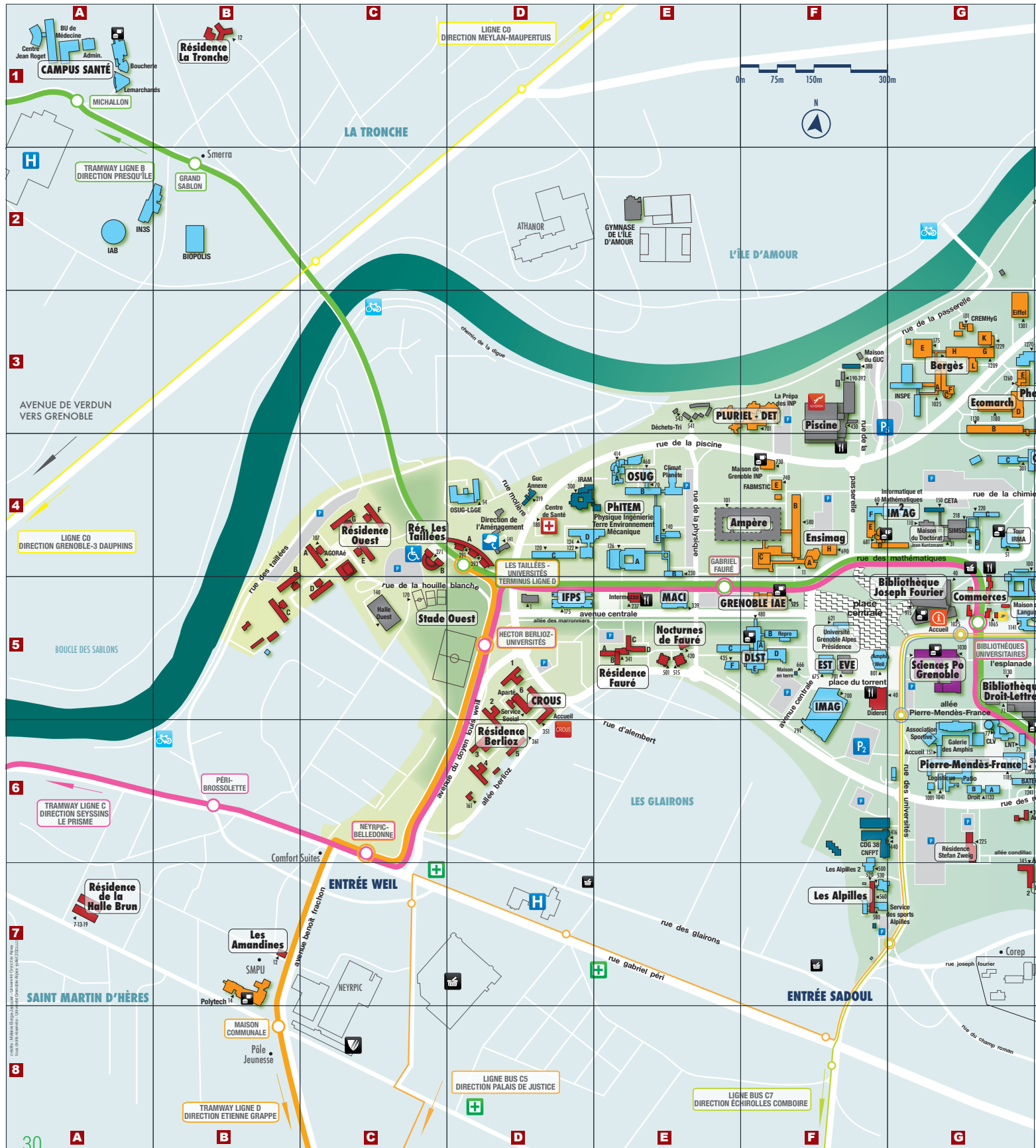
